announces a

Public Call for candidates for early stage researchers with selected mentors in 2008

1. Subject of Public Call:

The subject of this public call is the selection of early stage researchers who will start training with selected mentors for the obtainment of a Ph.D. degree in science in the following research areas:

2. The early stage researcher shall meet the following conditions:

- he/she has graduated from a university (minimum requirement), possesses an appropriate degree with an grade point average in all courses (examinations and exercises - except diploma work) of at least 8.00, and fulfils the requirements of enrolment in postgraduate studies to obtain a scientific title;
- or he/she has concluded Bologna level 2 studies in an appropriate field, and reached an grade point average in all courses (examinations and exercises - except diploma work) of at least 8.00:
- or he/she has concluded a master's in a scientific subject;
- he/she must not be older than 28 years (year of birth is considered); if the early stage
 researcher has already enrolled in postgraduate studies and is not supported by the agency or
 the ministry of science, the age limit will be raised above 28 years by one year for each
 academic year registered;
- if the early stage researcher has already enrolled in postgraduate studies leading to a scientific title or concluded master's studies or concluded a master's in a scientific subject, the grade point average of undergraduate studies is of no importance;
- if the early stage researcher has benefited from maternity or parent leave 1 year will be credited per child the age limit will be raised above 28 years, by the period of leave actually used. The same applies to (documented) extended absence due to illness or due to the performance of military service.

Early stage researchers who have already been financed through an early stage research program, but have prematurely terminated their contract or have not concluded the program within the contractual period, are not eligible to compete in this call for applications.

3. Criteria for assessment of candidates:

- grade point average in all courses (examinations and exercises except diploma work);
 candidates must have already passed at least 80% of all examinations and exercises in their undergraduate studies;
- obtainment of scientific master's degree:
- enrolment in postgraduate studies for obtainment of scientific title;
- · awards or prizes received;
- articles published;
- participation in research work.



The evaluation of the criteria listed can be seen from the attached form "Confirmation and assessment sheet". The mentors will examine whether the candidates fulfil the conditions and will assess them on the basis of the criteria set above.

4. Content of applications:

Applications to the public call **must** include:

1. Application form no. MR/2008 – filled in completely, and signed

as well as the independent attachments:

- 2. Proof of education:
- photocopy of university degree or photocopy of degree in Bologna level 2 studies (foreigners shall provide an official translation); or
- written statement (STATEMENT No. 1) that the candidate will graduate from his/her bachelor's or master's studies no later than by 17th Sep 2008 and will provide, no later than by that day, a certificate of graduation or of defence of master's theses;
- photocopy of a scientific master's degree or certificate of defence of master's thesis; or
- if the candidate has already enrolled in postgraduate studies, he/she must enclose an enrolment certificate as well as a certificate of fulfilled duties in postgraduate studies.
- 3. Proof of grade point average in undergraduate studies (i.e. supplement to the degree or officially certified list of all examinations and exercises taken, from which the grade point average can be seen correct to two decimal places), as well proof of performance of at least 80% of all examinations and exercises in his/her undergraduate studies;
- 4. Citizenship certificate (photocopy of identity card or passport);
- 5. Written statement on data privacy signed by candidate (STATEMENT No. 2);
- 6. Written statement signed by candidate declaring that he/she has not been financed in an early stage research program so far (STATEMENT No. 3).

The application **may** include the following attachments:

- 7. Proof of awards and prizes obtained, list of published scientific articles, and proof of participation in research work;
- 8. Proof of possible maternity or parent leave, or extended absence due to illness or military service.

5. Period of employment relationship:

The Institute will form an employment relationship for the definite period for the obtainment of a scientific Ph.D. as specified by the Slovenian Research Agency (ARRS) pursuant to Article 28 on the training and financing of early stage researchers in research organisations, which shall last no more than:

- the maximum period of four years and six months if they have enrolled in a four-year Ph.D. study program (old program);
- the maximum of three years and six months if they have enrolled in a study program in accordance with Bologna level 3 (new program).

or an appropriately shorter period in the cases specified in Article 28 of the Rules on training and financing of early stage researchers in research organisations.



Applications in writing with attachments and compulsory mention of the mentor with which the candidate wishes to train, must be delivered **by registered mail no later than and including 30th May 2008** to the following address: Jožef Stefan Institute, Jamova cesta 39, SI – 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia, with the label "**Do not open – application to public call for early stage researchers in 2008**".

Each envelope may contain the application written in for one mentor only.

Applications will be treated in the selection procedure only if they have been delivered to the address of the Institute within the application period.

The selection of early stage researcher candidates will be performed by the Institute in mutual agreement with the selected mentors.

The candidates will be informed of the selection results within an estimated period of 20 days after conclusion of the call for applications.



With foreign citizens, a sensible conversion of the grade points will be taken into account.

² Prior to the conclusion of the contract, the candidate must graduate and reach an average point grade of all examinations and exercises of at least 8.00!

³ If the candidate has no financial support by the agency or ministry of science, and has already enrolled in postgraduate studies, the age limit will be raised above 28 years - by one year for each academic year registered. If the candidate has benefited from maternity or parent leave – 1 year will be considered per child – the age limit will be raised above 28 years, by the period of leave actually used. The same applies to (documented) extended absence due to illness or due to the performance of military service.
